She screens each visitor and maintains the Visitor Log, tactfully turning away anyone who displays symptoms that pose a potential risk if they were to interface with the students. In addition, Ms. Padilla provides oversight to ensure each person entering the campus passes through the Clean-Room Entry System, a two-chamber controlled environment where pollutants like airborne microbes (bacteria/viruses), dust and aerosol particles are filtered out in order to provide the safest area possible.
