International STAND UP to Bullying Day 2020

February 28, 2020

International Stand Up to Bullying Day takes place on the last Friday of each February. This day is a special semi-annual event in which participants wear a pink shirt to take a visible, public stance against bullying. The students of Desert Lily Academy were eager to join in wearing bright pink shirts for the day.

The color of the shirts is based on a campaign started by Travis Price and David Shepherd, two students who took a stand for a fellow student who was bullied for wearing a pink shirt to school. International Stand Up to Bullying Day takes place in schools, workplaces, and organizations in 25 countries across the globe on the third Friday of November to coincide with Anti-bullying week, and then again on the last Friday of February. The day was first observed in February 2008.
